RCMRD

Kenya hosts the Regional Centre for Mapping of Resources for Development (RCMRD), which is a Regional Support Office for UN-SPIDER

RCMRD in collaboration with NASA-SERVIR has developed a comprehensive disaster risk reduction framework to guide the country and the region in disaster management



TAMs

RCMRD has actively participated in four (4) Technical Advisory Missions (TAMs): Sudan (2011), Malawi (2013), Zambia (2014) and Kenya (2014)

In all four cases, the TAMs had a huge impact as each country implemented the recommendations in follow up actions



IN KENYA

One of the Recommendations was on capacity building and awareness campaigns. RCMRD continues to work with the NSS and NDOC to implement them



WAY FORWARD

Kenya will continue to work with UN-SPIDER and UNOOSA to ensure the integration of satellite-based approaches in disaster resilience
